ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Qualified in NEET exam conducted by the National Testing Agency
- Age: Minimum age should be 17 years to apply
- Academics: 12th standard with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology
- Subjects: PCB (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) must be core subjects
- General Category: Minimum aggregate of 50% in PCB for the General Category
- Reserve Categories: Minimum aggregate 40% in PCB with practical for reserved categories

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: July.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including NEET qualification for Indian students planning to return and practice in India after...
2. Step 2: Complete 12th standard with a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (40% for reserved categories).
3. Step 3: Gather necessary documents as per the university's requirements for international students.
4. Step 4: Submit qualification proofs and test scores, including IELTS if required by the university.
5. Step 5: Prepare for a simplified application process as AUF does not require an entrance exam for MBBS admission.
6. Step 6: Apply for admission to the MBBS program, noting that seats are currently open for the academic year.
