ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET as per NMC guidelines for the 2026 intake.
- Age: Minimum 17 years of age as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: Minimum 60% marks in 12th standard/HSSC/A-Levels (Pre-Medical) are required.
- Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must be included in the qualifying examination.
- English Proficiency: Good command of the English language is essential as the MBBS program is taught in English.
- Health: The student must be medically fit to pursue the MBBS program.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Online Application: Start by applying online through the university website or contact admission experts for guidance. You can also visit...
2. Step 2: Document Submission: Submit scanned copies of required documents, including academic transcripts, passport, and NEET scorecard, ensuring...
3. Step 3: Eligibility Check: Ensure you have a minimum of 60% marks in your senior high school (Grade 12/HSSC) with pre-medical subjects to be...
4. Step 4: Age Verification: Confirm that you are under 30 years of age, as this is the upper age limit for applications to the Asian Medical Institute.
5. Step 5: Admission Letter: Await the issuance of the admission letter, which typically takes 3–7 working days after submitting the required documents.
6. Step 6: E-Visa Application: After receiving the admission confirmation, apply for an E-Visa letter by paying approximately \$200 (₹16,600 approx.)...
