- Passport: Valid passport is required for visa processing.

1. Step 1: NEET Qualification: Indian students must qualify for the NEET UG exam with a score meeting the university's cutoff criteria.
2. Step 2: Application Form: Obtain the application form from Centro Escolar University's official website or authorized admission partners.
3. Step 3: Document Submission: Submit required documents, including NEET score card, 10th and 12th mark sheets, passport copy, and passport-sized...
4. Step 4: Eligibility Check: The university will verify the submitted documents to ensure the student meets the eligibility criteria.
5. Step 5: Application Fee: Pay the application fee as specified by the university. Details will be available on their website.
6. Step 6: Provisional Admission: If eligible, receive a provisional admission letter from Centro Escolar University.
