ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Required for Indian students as per NMC guidelines.
- Age: Minimum 17 years as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Minimum Marks: Overall 60% score on Senior High School Diploma/HSSC/WAEC/GCE-A Levels. Some universities require 70%.
- PCB Score: For Indian and Bangladeshi students, a 75% score with excellent grades in English and PCB (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) is required.
- HSK Level: Clear HSK Level 4 (Chinese language proficiency test) at the end of the 1st year.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET exam, as it is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission abroad.
3. Step 3: Prepare your high school credentials for submission, as admission is based on academic performance.
4. Step 4: Obtain an Eligibility Certificate to pursue Primary Medical Qualification (MBBS or its equivalent) as per MCI guidelines.
5. Step 5: Be prepared to clear HSK Level 4 at the end of the 1st year, as per the Ministry of Education China rules.
6. Step 6: Apply through the online portal, starting around March for the intake of that year.
