It gained university status in 1994 and was awarded National Medical University (NMU) status in 2007, reflecting its leadership in medical education across Eastern Europe. The university removed M. Gorky's name from its title in 2017 to align with modern Ukrainian cultural reforms. ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Compulsory qualification for Indian students.
- Age: Minimum 17 years at the time of admission.
- Academics: 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- Minimum marks: 50% aggregate in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 10+2.
- Subjects: Must have passed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as subjects.
- Qualifying Exam: Admission based on credentials and NEET/interview performance.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being at least 17 years old and having passed 12th grade with Physics, Chemistry, and...
2. Step 2: Verify you have a minimum of 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in your 12th-grade examination.
3. Step 3: Qualify for the NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) exam, as it is compulsory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission.
4. Step 4: Gather required documents, which may include academic transcripts, NEET scorecard, passport copy, and passport-sized photographs.
5. Step 5: Apply online through the official Donetsk National Medical University website (WWW.DNMU.NET) for the 2026 September intake.
6. Step 6: Submit all necessary documents online as per the university's instructions. Ensure all documents are accurate and complete.
