- Passport: Valid passport is required for international travel.
- Visa: Student visa required to study in Georgia.

## HOW TO APPLY

2. Step 2: Gather all required documents, which may include academic transcripts, passport copies, and other necessary certificates.
3. Step 3: Contact expert counselors for detailed information on MBBS admission in Georgia and assistance with the application process.
4. Step 4: Submit your application to East European University, ensuring all documents are accurately filled and attached.
5. Step 5: Await the university's review of your application and notification of acceptance.
6. Step 6: Upon selection, promptly inform the university of your intended date of arrival for necessary preparations.
