ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must be NEET qualified as per NMC guidelines for the year 2026.
- Age: Minimum 17 years of age as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology as main subjects.

- Minimum Marks: Minimum 50% marks in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology) for the General category.
- Reserved Category: 40% marks in PCB for reserved categories as per Indian regulations.
- Passport: Must possess a valid passport for international travel.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including NEET qualification and 10+2 completion with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
2. Step 2: Prepare necessary documents, including mark sheets and passing certificates, for submission to Progress Medical University.
3. Step 3: All documents from Indian education boards must be advocated by the Ministry of External Affairs for Armenian university admission.
4. Step 4: Apply online through the university's official website or designated admission portal. Progress Medical University admission is 100% online.
5. Step 5: Submit your application on the single electronic platform <https://dimord.emis.am/> before August 8, 18:00.
6. Step 6: Await the offer letter from Progress Medical University after your application is reviewed. Admission is on a rolling basis.
