- Reserved categories: 40% in PCB for reserved categories.
- No entrance exam: Admission is 100% online and hassle-free.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being NEET qualified and having completed 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
2. Step 2: Aim for a minimum of 50% in PCB for the General category or 40% for reserved categories in your 10+2 examinations.
3. Step 3: Prepare required documents, including your NEET scorecard (if needed), 10th and 12th certificates, and passport-sized photographs.
4. Step 4: Obtain necessary documents like a transfer certificate, code of conduct certificate, and school-leaving certificate from your previous...
5. Step 5: Secure a certificate indicating no criminal offense against you, which may require a police clearance certificate.
6. Step 6: Provide a bank statement from your guardians showing sufficient funds (₹15–20 Lakhs) to cover tuition and living expenses.
