- **School certificate:** School Transfer Certificate is required.
- **Medical certificate:** A medical check-up certificate is essential.
- **English proficiency:** As the medium of instruction is English, students should be proficient.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Intake: September.

1. **Step 1:** Ensure you have a NEET Scorecard, as it is significant for Indian students seeking MBBS admission in the Philippines.
2. **Step 2:** Obtain your School Transfer Certificate, which is a mandatory document for the admission process.
3. **Step 3:** Secure a medical check-up certificate, as it is exceptionally essential for your application.
4. **Step 4:** Apply to a top medical university in the Philippines, keeping in mind the application deadline of December 2025 for the 2026 intake.

- Step 5: Submit all required documents, ensuring they meet the eligibility criteria set by the university.
- Step 6: Await the medical university's review and approval of your admission form.
