ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Must qualify NEET with a valid score (minimum 50th percentile for General category).
- **Age:** Applicant must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- **Academics:** Completion of 12th standard with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Qualifying Exam:** NEET qualification is mandatory for studying MBBS abroad from 2018 onwards.
- **Migration Certificate:** Required from the previous educational institute.
- **Intake:** Russian universities typically have only one intake per year.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. **Step 1: NEET Qualification:** Qualify for the NEET-UG exam as it is mandatory for MBBS admission abroad.
2. **Step 2: Application Submission:** Apply to Institute Of Oncology Moscow through their official website for the 2026–2027 academic year.
3. **Step 3: Document Preparation:** Prepare all required documents, including academic transcripts and migration certificate.
4. **Step 4: Eligibility Check:** Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including minimum marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 12th standard.

5. Step 5: Application Review: The university will review your application and documents for completeness and accuracy.
6. Step 6: Admission Offer: If selected, you will receive an admission offer from the university.
