## ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Must qualify NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
- **12th/Inter marks:** 50% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) for general category.
- **12th/Inter marks:** 40% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) for reserved category.

- Qualifying Exam: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent from a recognized board.
- Subjects in 12th: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English are mandatory.
- Minimum Percentage: A minimum of 50% aggregate in PCB is generally required.

## HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including 50% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology for the general...
2. Step 2: Reserved category students require a minimum of 40% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in their 12th/Inter/Equivalent.
3. Step 3: Qualify for the NEET exam. Your NEET qualification from 2024, 2025, or 2026 is acceptable for admission in 2026.
4. Step 4: Gather all necessary documents, including your 10th and 12th mark sheets, NEET scorecard, passport, and passport-sized photographs.
5. Step 5: Contact the university or an authorized admission partner for guidance on the application process.
6. Step 6: Complete the application form accurately and submit it along with the required documents.
