- NEET Admit Card: Submission required during the admission process.
- COVID-19 Report: Submission may be required based on prevailing guidelines.
- Birth Certificate: Required for verification during MBBS admission.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: January.

1. Step 1: Qualify for NEET: Ensure you meet the NEET eligibility criteria as per the National Medical Commission (NMC) guidelines for the 2026 intake.
2. Step 2: Apply Online: Begin your application through CareerMarg.com, the official admission partner for MBBS programs in Bangladesh.
3. Step 3: Document Submission: Submit all required academic documents for verification and processing by the Directorate General of Medical Education...
4. Step 4: Receive Offer Letter: Await the Offer Letter/Letter of Acceptance (LoA) from Kumudini Women's Medical College upon successful verification.
5. Step 5: Visa Application: Start your visa application process for Bangladesh after receiving the acceptance letter from the college.
6. Step 6: Fee Payment: Pay the admission fee as per the college's guidelines before traveling to Bangladesh; note that fees are subject to change.
