Historical Foundation and Institutional Identity Kutaisi Medical Institute operates as the Faculty of Medicine within Kutaisi University, a private institution founded in 1992 by Valerian Kelbakiani and Revaz Laghidze. Located in Kutaisi, a city in west-central Georgia, this university holds the distinction of being the first private higher education institution in Georgia's western region. While the university itself has maintained operations for over three decades, the medical faculty represents a more recent development, having been established in 2019 with the Medical Doctor (MD) degree program commencing in 2021. As a privately owned, for-profit educational institution, Kutaisi University differs from Georgia's public medical universities, yet...

ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify in the NEET exam for the year 2026 application.
- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Qualification: 60% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class XII.
- Qualifying Exam: Completed 12th grade or equivalent from a recognized board.
- PCB Score: Cumulative score of 70% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology for open caste students.
- Reserved Category: Cumulative score of 45% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology for reserved caste students.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including a minimum of 60–70% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class XII (may vary based on...)
2. Step 2: Confirm you are at least 17 years old and not older than 25 years old at the time of application.
3. Step 3: Qualify for the NEET exam for the year you are applying to the MBBS program.
4. Step 4: Prepare the necessary documents, including a copy of your passport, high school certificate and transcripts.
5. Step 5: Gather additional documents such as a Bachelor's degree certificate (if applicable), proof of English language proficiency, and a statement...
6. Step 6: Obtain a passport-sized photograph and the application fee payment receipt.
