ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Qualification: Must qualify for the NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
- Minimum Age: Applicants must be 17+ years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academic Requirement: 50% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent (PCB) for general category students.
- Reserved Category: 40% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent (PCB) for reserved category students.
- Qualifying Subjects: Physics, Chemistry, and Biology must be included in 12th standard.
- Passport Validity: A valid passport with at least one year of validity is required.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including 50% marks in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) in 12th standard (40% for reserved...)
2. Step 2: Qualify for the NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
3. Step 3: Prepare scanned copies of your 12th mark sheets, passport, and NEET qualification documents.
4. Step 4: Apply online for MBBS admission at Kyrgyz State Medical Academy (KSMA) or visit their offices with a prior appointment.
5. Step 5: Submit the scanned copies of required documents through the online application portal.
6. Step 6: Await confirmation from the university regarding your application status and eligibility.
