- NEET score: Required for Indian students (score details not specified)
- Age: Minimum 17 years as of December 31, 2026

- Interview: Required to assess aptitude and personal qualities
- Visa: Indian students need to apply for a Malaysian student visa

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Review eligibility criteria, including academic qualifications and required scores in exams like IELTS or TOEFL.
2. Step 2: Prepare necessary documents such as academic transcripts, passport copies, and other supporting documents.
3. Step 3: Submit your application form online or through the designated application portal of MAHSA University.
4. Step 4: Await communication from the university regarding the status of your application and further instructions.
5. Step 5: Prepare for an interview, which assesses your aptitude, motivation, and personal qualities for medical studies.
6. Step 6: During the interview, demonstrate insight into your personal attributes and understanding of a career in medicine.
