ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET UG exam; specific cutoff to be determined for 2026 admissions.
- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- PCB Marks: Minimum 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 10+2.
- English Proficiency: Course is taught in English, but IELTS/TOEFL not mandatory.
- Passport: Valid passport required for international travel and visa application.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Step 1: NEET Qualification: Qualify for the NEET UG exam as it is a mandatory requirement for MBBS admission in the Philippines.
2. Step 2: Application Submission: Apply to Mindanao State University (MSU) with the required documents. The last date for application is typically...
3. Step 3: Document Verification: Ensure all your documents, including academic transcripts and NEET score card, are verified by the university.
4. Step 4: Eligibility Check: MSU will assess your eligibility based on your academic qualifications and NEET score.
5. Step 5: Offer Letter: If eligible, you will receive an offer letter from Mindanao State University.
6. Step 6: Acceptance of Offer: Formally accept the offer letter and pay the initial admission fees to secure your seat.
