ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Qualification: Must qualify for the NEET exam as per NMC guidelines.
- Academic Performance: Admission based on academic performance and interview.
- Age Requirement: Must be 17+ years old as of December 31, 2026 (assumed).
- English Proficiency: Demonstrate proficiency in English, as the medium of instruction is English.
- Online Application: Apply through the online application process on the university website.
- No Entrance Exam: No additional entrance examination is required besides NEET.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Visit the official Mkhitar Gosh Armenian-Russian International University website to begin the online application process for the MBBS...
2. Step 2: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including a valid NEET score as per the National Medical Commission (NMC) guidelines for Indian...
3. Step 3: Submit your academic transcripts and other required documents through the online portal, demonstrating strong academic performance.
4. Step 4: Prepare for an interview, which is part of the admission process, to assess your suitability for the MBBS program.
5. Step 5: Demonstrate English language proficiency, as the MBBS program is taught in English. IELTS/TOEFL may be required.
6. Step 6: Await the admission decision from the university, which will be based on your academic record and interview performance.

- Birth certificate (English)
- Medical fitness & HIV test report
- Passport-size photographs (white background)
- 6-month bank statement of parent/guardian
- No-Objection Certificate
