ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify in the NEET exam for the 2026–2027 academic year.
- Age: Applicant must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.

- **Academics:** Completion of 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Minimum Marks:** Specific percentage requirements in 10+2 may apply; check university guidelines.
- **Nationality:** Indian nationals and international students are eligible to apply.
- **Medical Certificate:** Submission of a medical certificate is required to confirm fitness.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. **Step 1:** Ensure you meet the NEET cutoff criteria as mandated by the National Medical Commission (NMC) for the 2026 academic year.
2. **Step 2:** Verify that you have completed your 10+2 education with the required subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and minimum qualifying marks.
3. **Step 3:** Gather all necessary documents, including your academic transcripts, NEET scorecard, passport, and passport-sized photographs.
4. **Step 4:** Apply online through the university's official website or an authorized admission partner for the 2026-2027 academic session.
5. **Step 5:** Await the initial screening of your application by the university's admission committee.
6. **Step 6:** If shortlisted, prepare for a potential interview or entrance exam conducted by the university.
