- **Minimum marks:** Specific minimum marks in 10+2 may be required; check the university's official website for details.

- Nationality: Must be an Indian national or meet the specific eligibility criteria for international students.

5. Step 5: Await confirmation from the university regarding your application status and eligibility for admission.
6. Step 6: If selected, you will receive an admission letter from First Moscow State Medical University.
