ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Must qualify NEET with a valid score for the 2026 admissions.
- **Age:** Applicant must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- **Academics:** Completion of 12th grade with a minimum of 50% in PCB (Physics, Chemistry, Biology).
- **Subjects:** Mandatory subjects in 12th grade include Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- **Nationality:** Must be an Indian national or meet the specified criteria for international students.

- Entrance Exam: International students may need to clear an entrance exam conducted by the university.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Choose top 10 medical colleges in Russia, including First Moscow State Medical University, after personalized counseling.
2. Step 2: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including completion of 12th grade with a minimum of 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
3. Step 3: Qualify for the NEET exam. NEET qualification is mandatory for Indian students seeking MBBS admission in Russia.
4. Step 4: Prepare the necessary documents, including NEET result/admit card and ID proof (Aadhar, PAN, Driving License).
5. Step 5: Obtain an admission letter from First Moscow State Medical University after submitting your application.
6. Step 6: Arrange for currency conversion and other necessary documentation with assistance from educational consultants.
