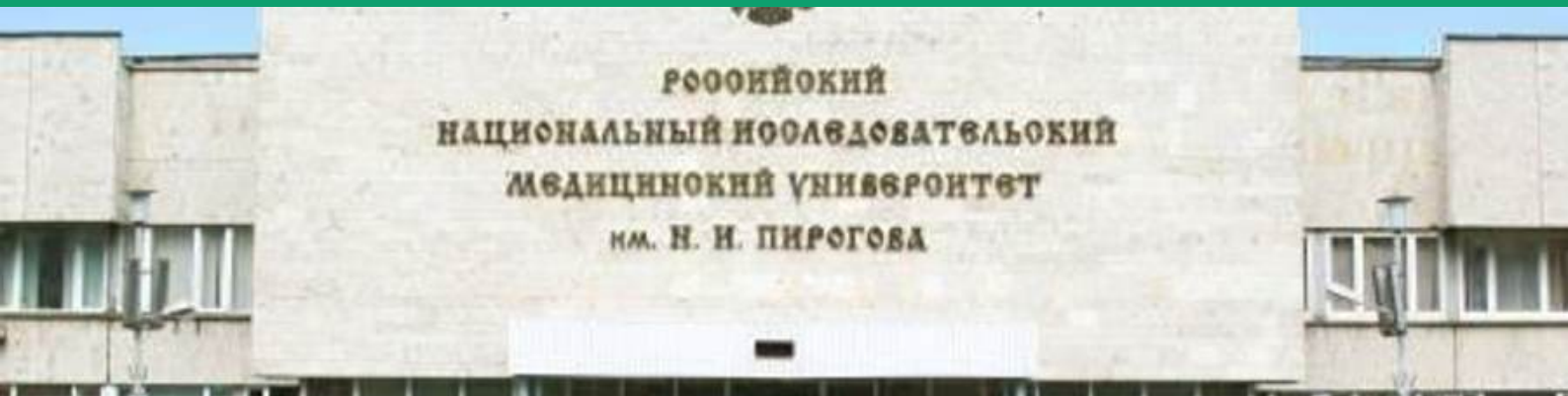

ELIGIBILITY

- **NEET score:** Qualifying NEET score is mandatory for admission.
- **Age:** 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.

- Academics: 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 12th standard for general category students.
- Academics: Reserved category students must have an aggregate of 50% marks in 12th standard.
- Qualifying Exam: Completion of 12th standard from a recognized board (CBSE / ISC or equivalent).
- Mandatory Subjects: Must have studied Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in 12th standard.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including being at least 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year (2026).
2. Step 2: General category students should have secured 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in their 12th standard.
3. Step 3: Reserved category students must have an aggregate of 50% marks to apply for admission.
4. Step 4: Qualify for the NEET examination. A valid NEET scorecard is mandatory for admission.
5. Step 5: Research the MBBS program at Moscow Institute of Medical and Social Rehabilitation, focusing on the curriculum.
6. Step 6: Visit the university's official website for the academic session 2026–27 to start the application process.
