ELIGIBILITY

- NEET Qualification: Must qualify for the NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026.
- Age: Applicants must be 17 years or older as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Submit scans of 12th standard mark sheets and passport for verification.

- Medium of study: The university offers MBBS programs in English.
- Recognition: Degree recognized by WHO, UNESCO, and NMC.
- Clinical Training: One year of clinical training in university-affiliated hospitals.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Qualify for NEET: Ensure you have cleared the NEET exam in 2024, 2025, or 2026 as it is a mandatory requirement for MBBS admission in Russia.
2. Step 2: Application Submission: Apply through the university's official website for the 2026-2027 academic session, ensuring all details are accurate.
3. Step 3: Document Submission: Submit scanned copies of your 12th standard mark sheet, passport, and NEET qualification documents as required by the...
4. Step 4: University Review: The university will review your application and submitted documents to assess your eligibility for the MBBS program.
5. Step 5: Admission Confirmation: Upon successful review, receive an admission confirmation letter from First Moscow State Medical University.
6. Step 6: Visa Application: Begin the process of applying for a student visa to Russia, which requires the admission confirmation and other documents.
