- NEET score: Mandatory qualification for Indian students.
- 10+2 or equivalent: Pass with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- PCB aggregate: Minimum 50% for General category.
- PCB aggregate: Minimum 40% for SC/ST/OBC categories.
- Entrance Exam: Qualify for MECEE-BL (if applicable).
- Age: 17 years or older by December 31, 2026 (general guideline).

HOW TO APPLY

1. Step 1: Qualify for NEET: Indian students must qualify for the National Eligibility Entrance Exam (NEET) to be eligible for MBBS admission.
2. Step 2: 10+2 Qualification: Applicants must have passed 10+2 or an equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, securing a minimum...
3. Step 3: Entrance Exam (MECEE-BL): Qualify for the Medical Education Commission Entrance Exam – Nepal (MECEE-BL) as required by the university.
4. Step 4: Application Submission: Apply through the official website of the Nepalese Army Institute of Health Sciences (NAIHS) for the MBBS program.
5. Step 5: Document Verification: Submit all required documents, including academic transcripts, NEET score card, and other necessary certificates, for...
6. Step 6: Merit-Based Selection: Admission is strictly based on the merit of entrance exams like TU-IOM and NEET scores.
