ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Mandatory qualification for Indian students.
- PCB score: 50% in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in Class 12 (40% for SC/ST/OBC).
- Age: Minimum 17 years old as of December 31, 2026.
- Academics: Submit SSC and HSC mark sheets during admission.
- Subjects: Required subjects in Class 12 are Biology, Physics, and Chemistry.
- Application: Apply directly on the official university website.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Appear for the NEET exam: Indian students must qualify for the National Eligibility Entrance Exam (NEET) to be eligible for MBBS admission.
2. Step 2: Secure qualifying NEET score: Students must secure a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in the NEET exam to proceed.
3. Step 3: Check eligibility criteria: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria, including minimum age of 17 years by December 31 of the admission year...
4. Step 4: Apply online: If eligible, apply directly through the official university website: <http://www.s-vfu.ru/en> for the registration process.
5. Step 5: Fill the application form: Complete the application form accurately with all required details and submit it online.
6. Step 6: Document submission: Submit necessary documents such as SSC and HSC mark sheets as part of your application.
