ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify in NEET 2026/2025/2024 as per NMC guidelines.
- Academics: 50% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent (PCB) for general category.
- Reserved Category: 40% marks in 12th/Inter/Equivalent (PCB) if applicable.
- Age: Must be 17 years old by December 31st of the admission year.
- Qualifying Exam: Successful completion of higher secondary education.
- Passport: Valid passport is required for international travel and visa processing.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: September.

1. Step 1: Submit scans of your 12th standard mark sheet, passport, and NEET qualification documents (2026/2025/2024) to the university.
2. Step 2: Ensure you have obtained at least 50% marks in your 12th standard (PCB) if you belong to the general category.
3. Step 3: Reserved category students need a minimum of 40% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in their 12th standard.
4. Step 4: Verify that you have qualified for the NEET exam in 2026, 2025, or 2024 as per NMC guidelines.
5. Step 5: Confirm that you will be 17 years old or above by December 31st of the application year (2026).
6. Step 6: Prepare for an online test that may be required by the university as part of the admission process.

- 6-month bank statement of parent/guardian
