ELIGIBILITY

- NEET score: Must qualify NEET in 2024, 2025, or 2026 as per NMC guidelines.
- Minimum marks: 50% in 12th/Inter (PCB) for general category students.
- Reserved category: 40% marks in 12th/Inter (PCB) are required.

- Age: Must be 17 years old by December 31st of the application year.
- Qualifying exams: Scans of 12th mark sheets and NEET qualification required.
- Application process: Submit required documents for initial assessment.

HOW TO APPLY

Intake: July.

1. Step 1: Submit scans of your 12th standard mark sheets, passport, and NEET qualification documents (2026/2025/2024) to the university.
2. Step 2: Ensure you have secured a minimum of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology in your 12th standard examination (40% for reserved...)
3. Step 3: Verify that you have qualified for the NEET exam in 2026, 2025, or 2024 as per NMC guidelines.
4. Step 4: Confirm that you will be at least 17 years old by December 31st of the application year (2026).
5. Step 5: Prepare for an online test that may be required by the university as part of the admission process.
6. Step 6: Obtain necessary medical reports as specified by Omsk State Medical University for international students.
