3. Step 3: Obtain a valid score in English proficiency tests like IELTS or TOEFL to demonstrate your language skills.
4. Step 4: Apply online through the university's official website or authorized representatives for international admissions.
5. Step 5: Submit your application form along with scanned copies of all necessary documents.
6. Step 6: Await the university's review of your application, which includes verification of your academic records.
